As parents and teachers, we realize it can be hard to get a child to discuss what he or she is learning in school. We hope the information provided on this page will assist you in communicating with your child about what he or she is learning.

For the next few days, your child will be learning about the basics of sewing by designing a fabric pattern and monogram, and by constructing a small bag while completing the Basic Sewing Module. As your child's best teacher, your participation in the learning process is extremely important.

Words students will learn in this Module include:

- backstitch
- batting
- bobbin
- dart
- feed dog
- grain
- handwheel
- interfacing
- presser foot
- salvages
- sewing gauge

Questions for discussion

During the course of this Module, your child will be assessed on key concepts and activities. You might want to discuss these concepts with your child.

He or she will be asked to:

- Measure and pin a half-inch fold along the bottom of a pocket. *(If possible, have your child demonstrate how to measure and pin a half-inch fold on a piece of fabric.)*
- Pin and stitch a zipper to the loot bag. *(Have your child explain the process he/she used to attach the zipper to the bag.)*
- Design a monogram with his/her initials. *(Have your child describe the monogram he/she designed.)*
