District Assessments Results Reviewed

Dr. Chris Messina provided a comprehensive review of the District performance on state and national tests. Congratulations are in order as each school in the district was awarded the designation of meeting the Annual Yearly Progress (AYP) benchmarks once again this year. ISAT results for the past four years were presented for grades three through eight, looking at both annual results and following a cohort group from year to year. Graduation statistics, academic achievements and PSAE results for the Lisle Senior High School were similarly presented. MAPS testing results were then explained as they provide a measure of student growth throughout the year as well as from year to year. School Improvement plans are being finalized in each building. These goals will provide focus for the improvement activities and efforts to help students continue to grow and exceed state standards.
