### **Library Grant Presented**

The District Learning Resource Center Directors presented a summary of their activities for the past year related to the 2009 State Library Grant. Student activities that encouraged reading and information access were highlighted. Lindsey Dorfman, the Lisle Public Library Youth Services Director attended to highlight the cooperative ventures between the school and public libraries.

### **Lisle Senior High School Improvement Plan**

Ron Logeman, LSHS Principal, presented the school improvement process and the resulting building goals developed by the high school faculty and staff earlier this year. He noted the faculty and staff's level of discussion and commitment to developing goals that helped students succeed. He began the presentation with the recognition of LSHS as an excellent high school with a great deal of success in the past but that the school improvement will give us a focus and a context for continued growth. Strong relationships have been the foundation upon which this success has been built and as LSHS moves forward through our process of addressing student needs, the faculty and staff will continue to prioritize these relationships in building an even stronger culture and commitment to helping students grow and meet their potential. The effectiveness of our Professional Learning Communities in helping teachers develop appropriate and consistent learning targets and assessments was highlighted. Better identifying at-risk students and developing a wider range of interventions to facilitate this growth were noted as a focus for the future efforts.
