While enjoying the jazz performances families can support our Lisle District 202 Band Program by participating in a number of fun raffles and purchasing delicious refreshments served by our senior high band students. Cabaret Night patrons will surely want to try their luck with the TopHat and Grand Raffles. Look for more items to bid on in our Silent Auction too! Grand Raffle tickets will be sold by band families prior to the event, as well as during Cabaret Night. The Top Hat Raffle will be held in the high school commons. All band families are encouraged to invite friends, family and alumni to attend Cabaret Night. 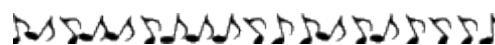

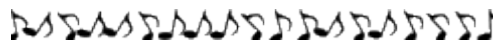
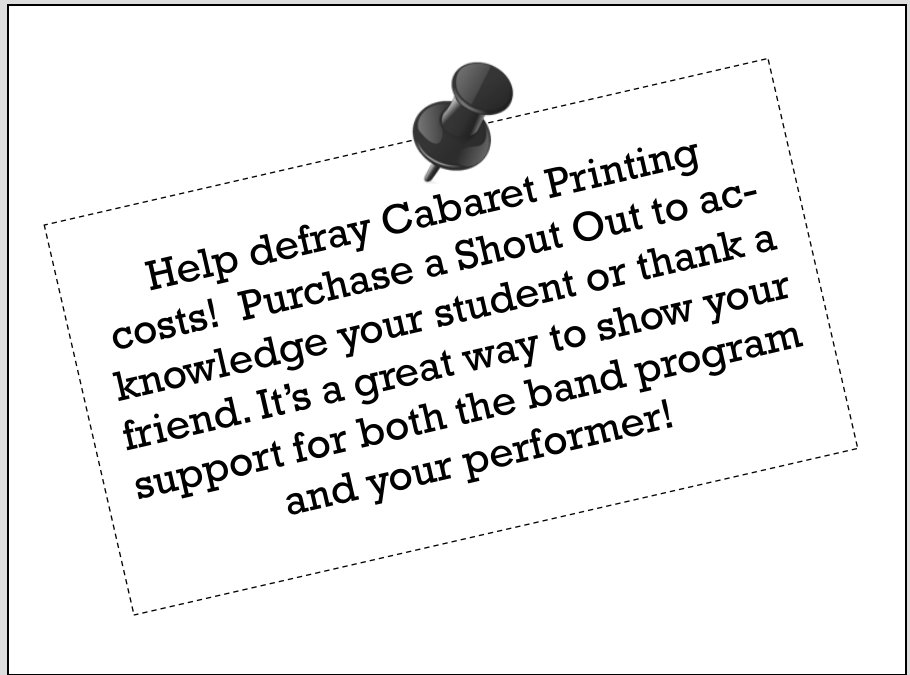


# Shout-Out!

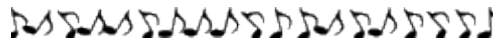
