

Classroom Rules

- I. Homework
 - A. To be done in pencil
 - B. Assigned daily
 - C. Quiz may be given over the homework (homework can be used)
 - D. 2 late works accepted per quarter
 - E. Is worth 2 - 5 points (May be collected randomly or daily)
 - F. To be kept to study for quizzes and tests
 - G. May be used on quizzes or tests

- II. Quizzes and Tests
 - A. Will be given after material is presented
 - B. Are usually announced or written on board
 - C. Quizzes are worth from 1 to 20 points
 - D. Tests are worth from 50 to 100 points
 - E. Some quizzes will be given from the homework

- III. Grades
 - A. Are based on total points
 - B. Are your points divided by total points possible
 - C. Are 4/5 for the two quarters and 1/5 for the semester exam to calculate the semester grade

- IV. Class procedures
 - A. Go over homework. **CHECK WITH A PEN**
 - B. Go over new material
 - C. Work on new homework
 - D. Working in groups is encouraged
 - E. If you miss a quiz or test, then be ready to take the quiz or test the next school day
 - F. Loss of 1 point for a book cover check

- V. Other
 - A. No food
 - B. No drinks (this includes water)
 - C. No cell phones
 - D. No book bags
 - E. No winter coats

Behavior Rules

Points will be deducted from your total points for the following reasons

Misbehavior – Loss of **TWO** points for each infraction.

- A) Excessive talking
- B) Talking without permission
- C) Talking after a Test or Quiz
- D) Getting out of seat during lecture
- E) Writing on desks
- F) Throwing objects
- G) Disrespect to anyone
- H) Other

Misbehavior – Loss of **FIVE** points for each infraction.

- A) A substitute teacher writes down your name
- B) Put in hallway for any reason
- C) If you are assigned a detention with Mr. Coit and you fail to show. A detention will be assigned through the Assistant Principal's Office
- D) Other

If you are placed in the hallway, then to be allowed to return to the classroom, these may apply:

- A) Student-Teacher conference
- B) Conference with the Assistant Principal
- C) Parent conference
- D) Other
- E) Any combination of the above

I keep track of tardiness. If you receive 4 or more tardies in one quarter, then you will not be eligible for extra credit. You are expected to behave like young men and women at all time, and even better for a substitute teacher.

You are expected to do all homework assignments and turn them in on time (next day). If you are sick, then you have as many days to make up the work. If you are unexcused or suspended, then you may receive a zero for the work.

If you go on a field trip or other function, then turn your homework in to me or give it to a fellow student to turn in for you the **day the assignment is due**, not the next day.
