

## **Lisle School District 202 Board Highlights Aug. 20, 2007**

### **Lisle's ACT scores up significantly from last year**

ACT scores for Lisle Senior High School's graduating Class of 2007 rose significantly from 22.4 in 2006 to 22.8 in 2007. All Lisle Senior High School juniors took the ACT exam in the spring of 2007. The average ACT score for students in Illinois was 20.5 and the national average was 21.1. Illinois is one of the few states to have all of its students take the ACT, rather than just college-bound juniors.

More than 140,000 Illinois students took the ACT. The results released in August by ACT, the national testing company, were for all Illinois 11<sup>th</sup> graders who took the test during the 2006-07 school year.

### **Board of Education approves teachers' contract**

The Lisle School District 202 Board of Education approved a three-year contract with the Lisle Education Association, the group that represents 140 teachers in District 202. The LEA ratified the contract, which runs from 2007 to 2010 and gives teachers a 4.9 percent annual raise over the three years.
