

## **Lisle School District 202 Board of Education Highlights February 2009**

### **School Board approves 2009-2010 calendar with emergency day provision**

The Lisle School District 202 Board of Education approved the 2009-2010 school calendar at its January meeting, but district officials recommended that in case a third emergency day was needed, Casimir Pulaski Day could be used, so the end of the school year would remain unchanged. Next year, Pulaski Day is scheduled for March 1.

### **Enrollment projections show slight decrease**

In order to complete staffing recommendations for the next school year, Superintendent Patricia Wernet discussed District 202 enrollment projections for 2009-2010. The district plans to maintain class size averages, instructional support services and extracurricular programs in keeping with the commitment made to voters during the 2004 referendum. The target goals for class size averages are: kindergarten, 20 or fewer; grades 1-2, 22 or fewer; grades 3-5, 24 or few students; and the junior and senior high core subjects, 25 or few students. The district is projecting approximately +50 fewer students overall.
