Monthly Electronics & Battery Recycling

3rd Saturday of each month

Beginning Saturday, November 20, 2010 residents can drop off unwanted electronics and old household batteries for recycling, free of charge, during the Village of Lisle's monthly collection events.

The Village's electronics and battery collection events will take place the third Saturday of each month from 9:00 a.m. until noon at 4930 Lincoln Avenue (IL Route 53). Volunteers and employees from Creative Recycling will unload participants' recyclables.

Items Accepted Include-

Electronics (such as computers, phones, televisions, monitors, VCRs, fax machines, video games, stereos, and printers)

Small household appliances (such as blenders, toasters and alarm clocks.)

Household batteries (such as AA, AAA, D batteries, hearing aid batteries, lithium batteries; camera batteries)

Please no hazardous waste or electronics containing liquids or other hazardous material (such as refrigerators, air conditioners, or batteries for vehicles, boats or sump pumps).
