

Lisle School District 202 Board of Education Highlights Jan. 26, 2009

School calendar extended

Due to the three snow days used this school year, Dec. 19 and Jan. 15-16, the last day of school will be June 9, if there are no other emergency days used. Five emergency days were built into the official school calendar when it was approved by the board in February 2008. Commencement will be held June 5. The Lisle School District 202 Board of Education approved the amended school calendar at its Jan. 26 meeting. The board also had a chance to see the proposed calendar for the 2009-2010 school year. School is set to begin on Aug. 24, 2009, and is scheduled to end on June 4, 2009.

Closed session minutes available to the public

The Lisle School District 202 Board of Education approved the release of closed session minutes from July 21, 2009 through Dec. 15, 2008, with the exception of Oct. 20 and Nov. 17, 2008, which had previously been determined to be of a confidential nature. The Board of Education is required to review the minutes of closed session meetings and approve their public availability on a semi-annual basis.

Board approves preparation of tentative FY 2010 budget

Each year, the School Code of Illinois requires that the Board of Education authorize the preparation of a tentative fiscal year budget. At its Jan. 26 meeting, the District 202 board authorized the superintendent and assistant superintendent for business affairs to prepare a tentative FY2010 budget. The board also approved the budget calendar. The board is expected to place the tentative FY2010 budget on display for public review on June 15 and is set to approve the budget at its Sept. 21 meeting.
