

Lisle School District 202 Board Highlights May 19, 2008

Summer improvements set to begin

The Lisle School District Board of Education approved a contract with Pavement Systems for asphalt and concrete repairs at its May 19 meeting. Throughout the summer, all four buildings will have driveways and parking lots patched, seal coated and restriped. In addition, the gravel parking area west of the senior high school will be paved and striped for parking and the gravel area behind the junior high school will be paved. The paved area on the west side of the senior high school will be expanded to allow sufficient maneuvering for garbage trucks. A plan for a proposed sidewalk leading from the street to the entrance of the senior high school will be bid in the near future.

Board of education appoints recording secretary and treasurer

The Lisle School District Board of Education appointed Camille Johnson as recording secretary/board clerk and Keith Filipiak as treasurer of the board at its May 19 meeting. Both will serve their terms during the 2008-09 school year. At April's meeting, the Board of Education elected officers: Pam Ahlmann is president, Kathy Chatman is vice president and Kari Altpeter is secretary. Board meetings are held the third Monday of each month with the exception of Nov. 25, Jan. 26, 2009 and Feb. 23, 2009.

Science Olympiad assistant coach approved

An assistant Science Olympiad coach position was approved May 19 by the Lisle School District 202 Board of Education. This year, head coach Natalie Keigher led the 27 sixth-through ninth-grade participants in the Science Olympiad to qualify for state competition. The students were second in Class A out of 20 schools and ninth overall out of 39 schools. The assistant coach position will allow additional students from sixth grade through 12th grade to participate.

Last day of school is June 2

Five emergency days are built into the school calendar each year. Because a snow day was used on Feb. 1, the Lisle School District Board of Education approved an amended 2007-08 official school calendar at its May 19 meeting. School will end this year on June 2.
