

## Medications

It is the policy of Lisle C.U.S.D. #202 to administer medications only to students with prior written permission from the parent/guardian and physician. The taking of any medication at school is discouraged unless it is necessary for the child to attend school. A **medication authorization form** is required to be on file for all medications that need to be administered at school, including over-the-counter medications. This form may be obtained from school offices or health offices. A new medication authorization form must be filled out if there are any changes in the student's medication during the school year. All medications must be in the original container, clearly labeled with the student's name, medication name, and dosage instructions. Medication must be brought to school by the parent. At the end of the school year, it is the parent's/guardian's responsibility to pick up any unused medication. A new medication authorization form must be filled out each new school year. A student may carry his/her inhaler and an EpiPen if properly instructed on
