ELEMENTARY COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

FIRST STEP: KINDERGARTEN TO FIRST GRADE (Level 1)

Eligibility: Students who have completed kindergarten and are performing at or below grade level.

This course has been designed to meet the needs of our young literacy learners who are recognizing environmental print, but not yet reading conventionally. This population of students received the symbols v+ or v in several different literacy areas on the Kindergarten Supplement. A small group setting, with several interactive, hands-on opportunities will be available for the students to augment their literacy growth.

FIRST STEP: KINDERGARTEN TO FIRST GRADE (Level 2)

WRITING WORKSHOP

WRITING WORKSHOP: OPTION A (Multiage Writers' Workshop)

Eligibility: Students who have completed grades 1-4.

This workshop atmosphere provides opportunities for writers to interact in flexible groups (grade level and cross grade level) and provides exposure to a variety of skills, modes and writing traits. The goal of this writing program is to develop composition skills at individual levels for students who have completed grades 1-4. The structure will be a Writers' Workshop setting and will include mini-lessons, daily writing time, revising practice, teacher and peer conferencing, and author sharing. Because the focus will be on the writing process, not product, students will not be publishing in class. Students must enjoy writing and have the ability and desire to write independently.
