RESULTS FOR 2010/2011 (How did we do?)

- All AYP targets were successfully met
- Math = 94.7(10-11 Goal) /92.6% (10-11 Performance)
- Reading = 90.4(10-11 Goal) /89.3% (10-11 Performance)
- Climate survey results were attained and resulted in school action plans
- Systems to support SEL through a standards-based plan were refined and up-graded
- Media coverage of TW and SES was increased
- Financial resources were utilized to support continuous improvements aligned to SIP

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS - 2011/2012

- Math ISAT 94.7% - Reading ISAT 92.5%
- 34 Students will sign the High Five/Lion Pride chart weekly, per K-5 classroom
- Ongoing implementation of SEL at PK-5 level to support student learning and RtI model
- Each certified staff member will submit 1 good news/curriculum story annually
- Remain within budget/decrease paper usage and overall energy usage at TW and SES

SPECIFIC AREAS OF GROWTH FOR 2011/2012

- Continue refinement of instructional practices resulting in an increase in student learning evidenced by ISAT performance in Reading and Math and MAP growth
- SEL instruction will be documented on framework for articulation purposes
- Intervention system will include plan for teaching pro-social behavior and a plan for preventing anti-social behavior
- Good news stories and curriculum successes will be shared through communication liaison
- Energy and financial conservation efforts will continue

ACTION PLANS

Examples of actions to meet goals include but are not limited to:

- Implementation of specific instruction to increase fluency of math facts and sight words
- Staff members will analyze student specific data and build plans for targeted improvement to address areas below standards
- Use of individual student MAP data to assist students in targeted areas of need
- Increase the frequency of positive feedback to students by staff
- Collaborative work through Building Leadership Teams to formalize and increase communication among staff
- Evaluate resource requests to ensure alignment with Board Goals 1-3
