Things you can recycle at lunch:

Soda cans (please empty)
Plastic bottles (please empty)
Glass containers (please empty)
Plastic frozen food trays/containers (please rinse out)
Frozen food boxes
Granola and energy bar wrappers
Chip bags with silver inside lining
Cookie and candy wrappers with silver inside lining
Yogurt containers (please rinse out)
Plastic fruit/jello/pudding cups
Metal soup/fruit cans
Aluminum foil

Things you can do in your classroom to save energy & recycle:

Put PAPER in the recycle bin!

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Recycle single use batteries (place them in your classroom milk jug)

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You can recycle cardboard boxes and poster board too

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Turn off lights when not in use. Use the natural light from windows (if you can)

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Keep cans, glass, and plastic bottles separate from paper

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Double-side documents when printing

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Download "Ecofont" for free. Using this font when printing will use 20-30% less ink and make toner last longer.
