Meeting Highlights

November 27, 2017

Tentative Tax Levy

The Board of Education approved the tentative property tax levy of \$28,516,000. Property tax bills in District 202 are projected to increase by the national Consumer Price Index (CPI) of 2.1%. Owners of a \$300,000 home should expect an increase for the portion of their tax bill related to the School District of approximately \$100 for 2018. The final property tax levy will be approved at the December 18, 2017 Board Meeting.

Lisle High School Parking Lot Renovation

Based on reviews of the parking lot condition, it was determined that the sections of the Lisle High School parking lot are beyond repair and need to be replaced; specifically, the north and west sections of the parking lot are at the end of their usability. As a result and with student safety in mind, the Board of Education approved a motion to collect bids to repair these sections and possibly other sections, which are nearing the end of life. The scope of the project will be dependent on the proposed cost in the bids submitted.

Lisle Elementary School Fixtures and Furniture Planning

The interior fixtures and furniture are important environmental components of the new elementary building. These items are not included as part of the architectural design of the building and are an extra service provided by Perkins & Will, however the cost is integrated into the specified total budget (considered “soft costs”). The service will include reviewing the current inventory, assisting with cost comparisons of new items and monitoring the process from selection to delivery. The Board will vote on this service at the next meeting.
