With the pending retirement of the current Administrative/Personnel Coordinator, Mrs. Gretchen Cimaglio, the Board approved the request to reorganize this position to a [Coordinator of Human Resources/Board Recording Secretary](#). This change will better meet the needs of the District's business office and the current functions provided by the business office to the District's employees. The updated job description will allow the position to focus on human resource and personnel functions for the school district.

[Sports & Activities Staffing Evaluation](#)

At a previous meeting, the Board of Education requested that the District review extra-curricular student participation, number of coaches/sponsors, and how many coaches/sponsors are needed based on student involvement. Some staffing needs are sport/activity dependent specifically related to the competition requirements, some sports are co-ed requiring one coach, and others are dependent on if an individual student needs sponsorship for a sport that is not offered such as swimming and bowling.
