1. **LJHS Registration**

NEW students to District #202 attending Lisle Junior High School:
Call the LJHS Main Office at 1.630.493.8202 to schedule an appointment to register your student.
Please read the information and see the documents for completion.

2. **Orientation for New Students to Lisle CUSD #202 who will attend LJHS & Incoming Sixth Grade Students:**

Orientation will take place on the evening of *Monday, August 13th*, beginning at 6:00 P.M. and ending at 7:00 P.M. The evening will begin with a general information session in the Auditorium. Students will receive their class schedule and locker assignments. There will be time for you & your student to locate classrooms and practice locker combinations. Class schedules *will not* be available before August 13th. We strongly encourage everyone to attend this evening.

3. **First Day of School**

The first day of school for all Lisle Junior High School students is *Wednesday, August 15, 2018*. This is a full school day, 8:00-3:00 PM. On this first day, to help the sixth grade students become more comfortable, various activities will take place during each period throughout the day to acclimate them to LJHS.

4. **MySchoolBucks**

MySchoolBucks is our payment program for student fees and student lunches. This program will be explained and you will create an account at your Registration appointment.

5. **PowerSchool**

PowerSchool is our Student Data and Emergency Contact Information program. This program will be explained and you will create an account at your Registration appointment.

6. **School Physicals & Sports Physicals**

All incoming 6th grade students will be required to present proof of a physical examination and immunizations prior to the start of the school year. Students not in compliance will be EXCLUDED on October 15, 2018.

If you plan to participate on one of our athletic teams, a current, up-to-date sports physical examination is required before you try-out or participate.

The 6th grade physical may also cover the 6th grade student as a sport physical. Please remember a sport physical is only valid for one calendar year from the date the physical is completed. It may be helpful to have the 6th grade physical completed during the summer so it will cover the entire school year. The physician **MUST** sign the required examination form and check both the physical education and interscholastic sports boxes.

7. **Participation Requirements for Sports & Activities**

A. To try out and/or participate in ***SPORTS*** at Lisle Junior High School, your student must have:

1. A current Physical (Physicals expire one year from the date issued)
2. An Account set-up and entry completed on our Sports website, *8 to 18 (explained at Registration)*
3. Paid Athletic fee completed online at our Sports website, *8 to 18 - Due at the beginning of the sport*

B. To participate in ***ACTIVITIES*** at Lisle Junior High School, your child must have
