

A RESOLUTION OF LISLE COMMUNITY UNIT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 202, DUPAGE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, ASCERTAINING THE PREVAILING RATE OF WAGES FOR LABORERS, MECHANICS, AND OTHER WORKERS EMPLOYED ON PUBLIC WORKS OF SAID SCHOOL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act Regulating Wages of Laborers, Mechanics and Other Workers Employed in Any Public Works by the State, County, City or Any Public Body or Any Political Subdivision or By Any One Under Contract for Public Works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being ILCS 130/1 et seq. (1993), and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that Lisle Community Unit School District No. 202 DuPage County, investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in the Act for laborers, mechanics, and other workers in the locality of said School District employed in performing construction of public works, for District No. 202.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Education of Lisle Community Unit School District No. 202 that:

Section 1: To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the School District is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the DuPage County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of September 1, 2017, a copy of that determination being available at the following web address:

As required by said Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rate of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's September determination and apply to any and all public works construction undertaken by the School District. The definition of any terms appearing in this Resolution which are also used in the aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

Section 2: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of the School District to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

Section 3: The Lisle Community Unit School District No. 202 Board of Education Secretary shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of this School District this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.


Section 4: The School District Board of Education Secretary shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, requesting copies of any

determination stating the particular rates and particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

Section 5: The School District Board of Education Secretary shall promptly file a certified copy of this Resolution with the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

Section 6: The School District Board of Education Secretary shall cause to be posted on the School District's website a copy of this Resolution, and such publication shall constitute notice that the determination is effective and that this is the determination of this public body.
